

INFORMATION ON PROCESSING THE PERSONAL DATA OF THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE BADZ GOALKEEPER CAMP AND THEIR LEGAL GUARDIANS

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT?

The purpose of this document is to provide you with information about the conditions under which the processing of your personal data will be carried out. If the terms "us" or "our company" are used in the following text, they refer to BADZ Koloděje, z.s.

WHY WILL MY PERSONAL DATA BE PROCESSED?

By signing your child up for the goalkeeper camp event of BADZ, you have entered into a contract with our company (hereinafter the "Contract") and have become our customer. The purpose of processing the personal data is to provide a performance under the contract (i.e. your child's participation in Sparta Camp) and the services arising therefrom and to send information relevant to the use of this service (hereinafter the "Service"). To be able to provide you with this service, we must work with your personal data.

WHO WILL PROCESS MY PERSONAL DATA?

WHAT PERSONAL DATA WILL BE PROCESSED AND WHAT IS THE LEGAL BASIS FOR AND PURPOSE OF THIS PROCESSING?

In order to fulfil the legal obligations that apply to us in connection with your Contract, we will process

(a) issued and received accounting and tax documents and the Contract, including all the information contained therein (in order to fulfil the obligation of proper and transparent accounting, the processing period is: 10 years after the year to which the record relates)

(b) information on the health status of your child if, during the BADZ camp, a situation occurs that must be recorded in a medical diary under Act no. 258/2000 Coll., on the protection of public health, and a medical fitness assessment and a certificate of non-infectiousness, which are also recorded in the medical diary (in order to fulfil the obligation to keep a medical diary, the processing period is: for the duration of the BADZ goalkeeper camp and 6 months after it has ended)

In order to fulfil our Company's obligations arising from the Contract, we will process the following information for the duration of the Contract

(a) identification and contact details: name, surname, phone number and e-mail address of the legal guardian of the participant of the BADZ camp (i.e. the person who concluded the Contract with us), and the identification data of your employer if you draw a contribution for a performance under the Contract from the employer, as well as the name, surname, date of birth, residence, phone number and e-mail address of the participant in the BADZ camp (i.e. the person in whose favour the contract is concluded)

(b) information on the provided/received performance and data necessary for the provision/receipt of the performance (what the performance consists in, when it was provided, the particulars of the performance, and the necessary cooperation), in particular: the type/post of the player, the period for which the participant in the BADZ camp is playing football, or the club and team for which he/she is playing, the jersey number, nickname/name on the jersey, the registration of the provided clothing and its size, special catering requirements, the details of your payments (including amounts returned), the beginning and end of the period, when the service is provided, information about a claim if you exercise a claim, or any other information provide by you. If you have entered into an agreement for the use of a portrait of your child for promotional purposes, this agreement and the data contained therein shall be included in the performance of the Contract.

We process this information for the purpose of fulfilling and executing the Contract. The Contract is the legal basis for this processing of personal data.

We will also process the following data

a) after the performance of the Contract, we will continue to process the aforementioned personal data (with the exception of data contained in the medical diary) on the grounds of our justified interest in substantiating the relevant legal action, substantiating the performance of the provided and received performance under the Contract, and for the exercise, or assessment, of any claims from defects of such a performance (the purpose of this processing is the legitimate interest of our company in the protection of their rights and the substantiation of the fulfilment of obligations arising from the contract, processing period: 10 years after the termination of the contractual relationship - in view of any statutes of limitations set by the Civil Code)

b) a portrait of a participant in the BADZ camp captured on a photograph or other visual or audiovisual record for the purpose of its publication on our communication channels (the purpose of this processing is the legitimate interest of our company in communicating with the legal guardian of the participant in the BADZ camp, the substantiation of the realized activities at the BADZ camp and the presentation of our activities to the public, processing period: indefinite). For the sake of completeness, we hereby inform you that the Office for Personal Data Protection does not consider published photographs or other records capturing only the course of a particular event and identified only by the name of the given event as personal data (see position <https://www.uoou.cz/ke-zverejnovani-osobnich-udaju-zaku-na-internetu/d-1589>).

We will continue to use the data above for the purpose of sending business communications related to the service for the duration of the service and for two years thereafter. The legal basis for this processing is our company's legitimate interest in developing and improving the quality of our products and services. The sending of these business communications may be cancelled at any time in the manner specified in every business communication.

The provision of personal data is not mandatory; if you do not provide us with personal data marked as mandatory in the service order or required by law,

we will not be able to provide you with the relevant service and will not conclude a contract for its provision it with you.

WHO WILL HAVE ACCESS TO MY PERSONAL DATA?

Employees of our company that are entrusted with specific tasks related to the purpose of personal data processing and data processors, namely the supplier of the mailing system and the supplier of the database system, will have access to your personal data. An up-to-date list of processors will be provided on request.

WILL MY PERSONAL DATA BE TRANSFERRED OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION?

WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS IN RELATION TO THE PROCESSING OF MY PERSONAL DATA?

You have the right to request access to your data at any time - this means that, at your request, we will provide you with information on what personal data is being processed, for what purpose, what source the personal data was obtained from, to whom your personal data was provided and the duration of the planned data storage period.

You have the right to request, at any time, the correction of inaccurate personal data or its completion if it is incomplete. You also have the right to request the deletion of personal data that is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was originally collected or which the controller is no longer entitled to use for other reasons (e.g. if it was processed illegally or its deletion is required by law).

You have the right to require that the processing of your personal data be restricted - this means that you can request us to not delete personal data that we would otherwise be obliged to delete, and you can also request us suspend the processing of your personal data until it is clarified whether or not the data being processed is accurate, or whether your objection to the processing of the personal data is justified (See the right to object below).

You have the right to the portability of your personal data - this means that you may request us to provide you with personal data that we are processing (if it is processed automatically) in electronic form so that it can be easily transferred to another data controller (service provider). This right only applies to personal data that we have obtained in electronic form based on your consent or a concluded contract.

You have the right to object, at any time, to the processing of your data for the purposes of direct marketing (sending business offers). If you do so, your personal data will no longer be used for this purpose. You also have the right to raise an objection to the processing of your personal data that is based on our legitimate interest - in such a case, we will continue to process your data only if there are serious justified reasons for doing so.

IN WHAT MANNER CAN I EXERCISE MY RIGHTS?

You can exercise your rights (including the right to object) with the personal data controller, namely our company. You can contact us in writing, over the phone or via e-mail (the contact details are specified above). HOW SHOULD I PROCEED IF I BELIEVE THAT MY PERSONAL DATA IS BEING PROCESSED UNLAWFULLY, I.E. IN CONFLICT WITH THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION?

DOES AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING (INCLUDING PROFILING) TAKE PLACE DURING THE PROCESSING OF MY PERSONAL DATA?

Automated decision-making is decision-making carried out by a machine (computer) without human intervention which has legal or other similarly serious consequences for you (such as the termination of a contract). Such processing of personal data does not take place in our company. The relevant steps are always decided on by a particular company employee.
